SPONSOR REPORT

No sponsor report was given.

OLD BUSINESS

Football Program Ads – The football booster club is still accepting ads for the program until 7-14-06, you will need to contact Karen Zink directly. Bonnie will not do any more ads.

CHEERS Website – Bridget discussed some of the things that should be included on the website. These could include the history, the competition team members, calendar of events, and pictures of all squads at different - events.

There was much discussion on who would oversee the website. If a cheer parent was in charge they could take the website with them when their team member left. If an outsider was in charge of the website it would belong to the CHEERS booster club. The Webmaster would put on whatever they were given and it would be put on in a timely manner. Harry Williams a website manager would charge \$1,000 to do a website for us. This includes \$400 to create and set it up and \$600 to maintain it (\$300/fall and \$300/spring). Judi James, a parent, will do it for free. Her brother is a

Webmaster and will help her with the site. After a lengthy discussion it was voted on by the club to let Judi Janes create a website for the CHEERS booster club.

Meet the Team - The dinner will be held Sat. Aug.26th. The senior cheerleaders are to provide a decorated cake to be auctioned off at the dinner. If there is not enough participation by the seniors then each squad will donate a cake.

Fundraiser Dinner & Silent Auction – The dinner and auction will be held Fri. Oct. 20th. The question was asked if the parents were the only ones who bought dinner tickets and came to the silent auction. The booster club will try to make the dinner a tradition by inviting all the Jr. High teams and the little league teams to come and cheer. The football team will also be invited (we go to their dinner). Cathy Vining volunteered to be chairperson for the dinner. A chairperson for the silent auction is still needed. The liaisons will be in charge of getting the baskets and the individual items together for each basket for the auction.

Cheerleader Banquet – Cathy Rutherford has already been working on the banquet. Cathy suggested that we have the banquet at the Marriott Hilton again this year. They have given her the same price we paid last year, but with a change in the menu. She has talked with Coach Garcia, the same DJ as last year. Cathy has also contacted Higgins Photography for pictures. Gwen Wilmeth made a motion to hold the banquet at the Marriott Hilton and to put down a deposit of \$1,000. Debbie Torres seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Ways & Means Committee – The committee discussed various items to be sold at the football games. All items would need the approval of Jerry Creel (athletic director). Items will be sold at freshman and J.V. games.

Thunder sticks: a sponsor has donated \$300 toward the purchase of thunder sticks in return for their name being printed on them. They would be sold for \$1.50/pair and all would be profit.

Shorts: Maroon soffee shorts with a gold deer head printed on the leg.

(Kouba printing) 100 shorts - \$6.50 each

150 shorts - \$6.00 each

T-Shirts: White t-shirts with a 2-color print.

(Kouba)

100 t-shirts - \$6.50 each

150 t-shirts - \$6.00 each

(Ace T-Shirts) 100 t-shirts - \$5.15

It was decided to have Kouba print the shorts and t-shirts so the colors would match.

Koozies: There is a \$35.00 set up fee.

250 koozies - .79

Hair ribbons: Each cheerleader will be asked to donate 10 decorated hair ribbons.

A motion was made by Diann Roberts to sell the items listed above. Jerrileen Lummus seconded the motion. The motion was approved by all present.

Storage Facility- In exchange for a storage room the CHEERS booster club will put an ad in the football program thanking the storage facility for their sponsorship. Dwainia Alford made a motion to pay \$200 for the ad. Cathy Rutherford seconded the motion. The motion passed.

CHEERS Banner- Kim Gaspard said the booster club banner is finished.

NEW BUSINESS

Practice at UC- Mrs. Waldrup has set up a time at University Cheer to be able to use their facilities and staff members. The fee will be \$35/month for each cheerleader. Mrs. Waldrup has asked CHEERS to pay \$15 for each cheerleader each month. After some discussion it was decided that Bridget will talk with Mrs. Waldrup and ask her to let us know how much she is short each month in fees and then CHEERS will vote on an amount to be donated to her budget.

Casa Ole Fundraiser – Each cheerleader will be given 10 tickets to sell. Each coupon is to be sold for \$5.00 and they need to be paid for ahead of time. (\$50.00 total) The tickets will be distributed before school starts.
