Attached is Deer Park Independent School District’s Highly Qualified (HQ) Teachers Summary Report for the 2006-2007 school year. The district report is listed first, followed by the campus reports.

The district did not meet the annual target in one small area: the district reported 99.34% HQ in the Arts for secondary schools. Deepwater Jr. High had one theater arts class that was taught by a music teacher. The music teacher was on a permit for certification, but was not HQ for the one theater arts class.
