

DP Football Booster Club
May 23, 2006
Meeting Minutes

President Lee Giddens opened the meeting and a motion to approve the minutes from the May 9th meeting was made and seconded - meeting minutes were approved.

Graduating senior football player Ryan Spain spoke about how the DPHS football program has inspired his life. Ryan plans on attending San Jac and then the University of Houston. Ryan was one of the recipients of a booster club scholarship, and it was presented to him by President Lee Giddens.

Treasurer Dee Alaniz presented the Treasurers report and copies were distributed to all present.

Mary Kunkle, Spring Director, discussed results of the spring game. Overall everything went well. Expenses of \$992.28 were incurred with an income of \$843.50 from concessions. Concession products left over from the spring game will be used in the concession stand at the first 7on7 game Thursday, June 8th. After seeing how products sell, a determination will be made on what to sell for the remainder of the 7on7 games. \$1800 was made on the auction of the autographed football during halftime at the varsity game.

Jodie Hollub with Sales was present and reported that sales went well at the Spring Game. \$1,625 worth of new items was sold and \$1390 worth of our old items was sold. Expenses were \$1388.22 which led to a profit of \$761.85 for the spring game. Jodie reported the stadium seats sold extremely well and she was able to locate them from a local vendor for \$6 less – they are the same except the logo is screen printed not embroidered. Discussion was held and a motion was made and passed to buy the screen printed stadium seats since they cost less and are from a local vendor where no shipping charges would be incurred.

Fall Director Susan Brown discussed Meet the Team preparations. Susan handed out information on catering quotes from four different caterers - with discussion following. A decision on who to go with will be made at the next meeting Thursday, June 1st. It was agreed to ask Rand Royall to be the auctioneer again this year as he has done a great job for the past 3 years. Discussion and agreement was made to keep the program agenda the same as it was last year. Decorating, silent auction, cashiers, etc. were discussed and plans are in the works.

Karen Zink discussed game day programs and ad sales. Football has the front cover and inside back cover of the program this year (we alternate with the Escorts). A motion was made and passed to offer Deer Park Storage the inside back cover in exchange for keeping our storage space. Ad sales were stressed as this is where we make our money - Please make a special effort to sell at least one ad for the program - Order forms are in the player packets and on our website at <http://www.dpsid.org/%7Efootball/> - please make copies and sell, sell, sell!

Player packets that include a letter from the President, Membership Application, Web Site Release Form, Game Day Shirt Order Form, Decal Order Form, Yard Sign Order Form, Program Ad Order Form, and Meet the Team Donation Letter, were distributed to all football players by Coach Massey last week.
