## LSC REWIND >>>

Abilene Christian bounced back from a loss last week to post the Lone Star Conference's second win over a Championship Subdivision team with a 45-27 triumph over Texas State, a member of the Southland Conference. The LSC improved to 2-1 this season against FCS teams.

The third week of the 2007 season also included wins by Eastern New Mexico, West Texas A&M, East Central, Tarleton State, Texas A&M-Commerce and Midwestern State.

Seven games are on the LSC slate for next Saturday including five crossover contests and two non-conference games.

## LSC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### Co-LSC North Offensive

#### Trent Miller, Texas A&M-Commerce, So., QB, Conroe, Texas/Conroe HS/Sam Houston State

In his first collegiate start at A&M-Commerce, Miller threw for 225 yards and three touchdowns to lead Texas A&M-Commerce to its first win over Texas A&M-Kingsville since 2001. It is the first time since Sept. 18, 2004 against Northeastern State that the Lions had three touchdown passes. He led the Lions on scoring drives in each quarter.

#### Marcus Johnson, East Central, So., QB, Abilene, Texas/Abilene HS

Johnson set school records for touchdown passes in a game (6) and yards passing in a game (386) as East Central beat Angelo State 48-31. Johnson completed passes to 11 different receivers and ended up with TD passes of 4, 6, 73, 30, 17 and 2 yards. His 73-yarder to Marcus Pitts for a TD in the second quarter was the longest pass play of the night.

### Co-LSC North Defensive

#### Will Clewis, Central Oklahoma, Sr., Linebacker, Fort Worth, Texas/Eastern Hills

Senior standout spearheaded UCO's dominating defensive effort in a frustrating 17-7 non-conference loss to Emporia State. Clewis finished with 15 tackles, including 2.5 for loss, as the Bronchos allowed just 67 total yards. The Hornets, who scored both touchdowns on interception returns, managed just 38 yards rushing in 37 attempts and hit 5-of-15 passes for 29 yards.

#### Robert McDonald-Douglas, East Central, Jr., Linebacker, Pasadena, Texas/Deer Park HS

McDonald-Douglas led the Tigers with 15 total tackles and two tackles for lost yards in the game.

### LSC South Offensive

#### Bernard Scott, Abilene Christian, Jr., RB, Vernon, Texas/Wichita Falls HS

Scott scored three touchdowns on the ground and one as a receiver as the Wildcats picked up their first win of the season with a 45-27 win over Texas State. Scott had three touchdowns in the first half (two rushing, one receiving) before putting the finishing touches on the upset with a 17-yard TD run in the fourth quarter.

### LSC South Defensive

#### David Reed, Eastern New Mexico, Sr., Defensive End, Loomis, Calif./Del Oro HS

Reed helped the Eastern New Mexico defense limit Northeastern State to 239 yards of offense (3.4 yards per play) as the Greyhounds improved to 2-0 on the season. Reed made the play of the game in the fourth quarter, when he sacked NSU's quarterback, forcing a fumble that was returned 58 yards for the game-winning touchdown. He finished the contest with four tackles, a sack, a forced fumble and one quarterback pressure.

### LSC South Special Teams

#### Stephen Arnold, Tarleton State, So., K, McKinney, Texas/McKinney

Arnold kicked two field goals, including a career-long 39-yarder to help lift the No. 22 Texans over the No. 16 Savage Storm. He was also five of five in extra points to score 11 points in the contest.

## **LSC FOOTBALL NOTES** (submitted by LSC SID's)

**Abilene Christian** Abilene Christian 45, Texas State 27...Billy Malone threw three touchdown passes in Saturday night's 45-27 win over Texas State, the 14th straight game in which he has thrown a TD pass and the seventh straight game in which he has thrown more than one TD pass. ... Senior MLB Cody Stutts and junior LB Mike Kern each had six tackles in the game for the Wildcats. ... After turning the ball over three times in last week's 27-17 loss to UCO, ACU did not have a turnover in Saturday's game against the Bobcats...1995 was also the last time a Division II team upended a nationally-ranked Division I FCS program. Texas State entered the game No. 19 in The Sports Network Weekly Top 25. Abilene Christian was ranked No. 24 in this week's AFCA Coaches' Poll. ... The Wildcats are now 15-7-3 all-time against Texas State (formerly known as Southwest Texas State), and have won the last two games played in San Marcos (2007 and 1986). ... ACU's win snapped a two-game road losing streak dating back to last year's season-ending road playoff last at West Texas A&M, and it also snapped a string that had seen the Wildcats lose three of their last four games and four of their last five games dating back to last season. ... Malone, who had three touchdown passes in the game, is now third in ACU history with 46 touchdown passes, trailing only ACU and LSC all-time leader Rex Lamberti (84 from 1984-86, 1993) and Jim Lindsey (61 from 1967-70) ... ACU junior WR Johnny Knox had his breakout game in the win over Texas State, catching eight passes for 164 yards and two scores. ... ACU senior MLB Cody Stutts is off to a great start in 2007 with 19 tackles, including six tackles (four solo) against Texas State. He had one sack and two tackles for loss as ACU held the Bobcats to just 128 yards rushing after they had run for more than 300 two weeks ago. ... Pre-season all-America defensive end Travis Carpenter, who led ACU and the LSC in sacks and tackles for loss last season, recorded his first sack and first tackle for loss of the season in ACU's win over Texas State. ... ACU's 28-0 halftime lead was its largest lead since it marched to a 35-0 lead against Angelo State last October in a 35-7 victory...

**Angelo State** #East Central 48, Angelo State 31...Daniel Thomas recorded his second game over the century mark in as many games to open up the 2007 season for the Rams. He rushed for a career-high 201 yards on 27 carries with two scores Saturday night in ASU's 48-31 loss at ECUL. He had touchdown runs of six and 15 yards in the second half against the Tigers. He added three catches for 41 yards for a total of 242 all-purpose yards against the Tigers. On the season, Thomas now has 303 yards (151.5 ypg) through two games...Edward Cantrell tallied a team-best nine tackles, including five solo stops, in the Rams' 48-31 loss at East Central. He added an assisted tackle for a loss for one yard...Brad Holcomb connected on three field goals and accounted for 11 points in the Rams' 48-31 loss at East Central. Holcomb has five field goals through two games and is the Rams' leading scorer with 18 points...

**Central Oklahoma** Emporia State 17, Central Oklahoma 7...

**East Central** #East Central 48, Angelo State 31...ECU's victory snapped a six-game home losing streak, dating back to 2005. The Tigers beat UCO 42-39 in their next-to-last home game in 2005. They lost to Southeastern in the final home game of 2005 and lost all five home games in 2006 before finally winning their home opener Saturday...The Tigers' 48 points were the most since a 56-7 victory over Oklahoma Panhandle State in the 2001 season...

**Eastern New Mexico** #Eastern New Mexico 14, Northeastern State 10...Michael Benton paced the Eastern New Mexico University offense in their victory over Northeastern State with 159 yards rushing, one touchdown. His 80-yard run on third and 18 from the Eastern 12-yard line set ENMU up for their first touchdown, and prevented the Riverhawks from getting good field position in what was a scoreless game at that point. The game was the second time this season that Benton has rushed for at least 159 yards...The Greyhounds have gotten off to a great start, winning both of their first two games, and winning a season opener on the road- something the team last accomplished in the 2003 season. In the two games combined, Eastern has out scored the opposition 77-30 and out rushed them by a 794-107 margin. The ENMU defense has turned it up a notch, recording seven sacks, while the offense has yet to give one up...Michael Benton has 341 yards rushing so far along with four touchdowns. Also seeing significant time under center has been JT Thompson, who has run for 227 yards...Last Thursday, an 80-yard sprint by Benton set up the game's first touchdown, and a huge sack by David Reed forced a fumble that was returned 52 yards by Kenneth Odie for the game-winning score as ENMU won 14-10. Reed has been extremely active in rushing the passer and has three quarterback hurries on the season. Jeremy Hibbler has been a force for ENMU at linebacker, and has 22 tackles in two games...

**Midwestern State** ^Midwestern State 47, Southwestern Oklahoma 10...Daniel Polk accounted for six of the Mustangs' seven touchdowns while leading the Mustangs to 445 total yards in a 47-10 blistering of SWOSU. The senior from Dallas, Texas was 11-for-16 for 210 yards through the air including three scoring strikes to DelJuan Lee (49, 56, 34), while also rushing for 75 more yards on 10 carries with three more scores. Polk finished the night with 285 total yards as MSU rolled up 445 yards against what had been the LSC's top defense in Southwestern Oklahoma, which had allowed a combined 340 yards in its previous two wins. With the six touchdowns, Polk surpassed former MSU standing Phillip Boggs as the all-time leader in TDs accounted for and now has 56 in his career. He now also has 29 career rushing touchdowns and is one score behind Ross Harrison on that all-time list...Frank Brown returned an interception 66 yards for a touchdown to give the Mustangs a commanding 20-0 lead on the first play of the second quarter. He also broke up a pass as he helped the MSU defense limit the Bulldogs to 4.4 yards per play...Ben White averaged 44.3 yards on three punts while placing two inside the 20-yard line. He showed great athleticism after scrambling for the ball on a fumbled snap in the third quarter. He sidestepped a Southwestern Oklahoma State rusher and boomed a 60 yarder that was downed at the SWOSU 14-yard line...MSU improved to 23-5 (.821) at Memorial Stadium during the Bill Maskill era... When SWOSU's Spenser Daniel connected on a 24-yard field goal at the halftime buzzer, the Bulldogs snapped a 195:02 scoring drought at Memorial Stadium. The last time SWOSU scored was on Nov. 11, 2000 when Anthony Davis scored on a 10-yard run with two seconds remaining in the opening quarter... MSU improved to 18-1 (.947) in games played against LSC North competition during the Maskill era... Saturday night's win over the Bulldogs was also MSU 19th straight win over school from the state of Oklahoma and they have won all 16 since Maskill took over before the 2002 season... MSU's last loss to an Oklahoma institution of higher education came in a 31-28 loss to East Central on Oct. 6, 2001 in Ada... The Mustangs have also won their last 15 games against Oklahoma school played at Memorial Stadium dating back to a 42-14 loss to Central Oklahoma on Sep. 25, 1999... Senior wideout DelJuan Lee caught three passes for 139 yards - all for touchdowns (49, 56, 34)... True freshman Marcus Mathis paced the Mustangs in rushing for the second time in as many games as the Rockwall (Texas) HS product ran for 75 yards on 18 carries, including a 61-yard blast in the first quarter... transfer B.J. Mathis returned four punts for 57 yards with a long of 23 yards for an average of 14.3 yards a return... MSU special teams limited SWOSU to 28 kick return yards on Saturday which was a great improvement from the 210 kick return yards the Mustangs allowed at Adams State on Aug. 25. Both teams registered six returns... True freshman safety Ryan Craven had seven tackles for the second-straight game...

**Northeastern State** #Eastern New Mexico 14, Northeastern State 10...

**Southeastern Oklahoma** #Tarlton State 41, Southeastern Oklahoma 17...In two games this season Jerome Hewitt has returned eight kicks for 334 yards, for an average of 41.8 per return...SOSU has outgained its opponents in return yards by a 470-to-254 margin...The Storm has held its opponents to an 11-of-28 conversion mark on third downs...Kolby Williams has a passing efficiency rating of 134.59 on the season.

**Southwestern Oklahoma** ^Midwestern State 47, Southwestern Oklahoma 10...Wide receiver Johnathan Haggerty had his third career game in which he caught passes totalling more than 100 yards, snaring five passes for 142 yards and a touchdown in a 47-10 loss at Midwestern State. Haggerty, now a sophomore, caught passes for 133 yards against Texas A&M-Kingsville and 109 yards against Tarleton State as a freshman.

**Tarlton State** #Tarlton State 41, Southeastern Oklahoma 17...Roderick Smith ran for over 100 yards for the third game of the season and scored two touchdowns with a 61-yard touchdown run and also punched it in from four yards out...Ranardrick Phillips intercepted the ball in the SOSU endzone to keep the Savage Storm from scoring...The Texans racked up 560 yards of total offense... Michael Sampson had 10 carries for 63 yards in his first game of the season back from injury... In his first game of the season, Shamarr Prentice hauled in eight passes for 162 yards while Tarleton's leading receiver had four receptions for 56 yards and a touchdown (his fourth of the season)... Scott Grantham threw for 293 yards and one touchdown while going 17 of 25... The offensive line allowed just one sack Saturday... The Texan defense was led by Ranardrick Phillips with eight tackles, including six solo stops and a tackle for loss of four yards... He also recorded one interception, as did Blake Bueltel who returned the ball 24 yards... Sam Dolen scored his first touchdown of his career after recovering a fumble in the endzone for Tarleton...

**Texas A&M-Commerce** ^Texas A&M-Commerce 24, Texas A&M-Kingsville 7...

**Texas A&M-Kingsville** ^Texas A&M-Commerce 24, Texas A&M-Kingsville 7...Cody Smith had an outstanding game, pinning the Lions back with a 51-yard punt at their own 12, a 46-yard punt to the 19 yard line, a 53-yard punt to the Lion 13 and forced two fair catches.

**West Texas A&M** West Texas A&M 63, Adams State 20...Keith Null continues to show fans that the Buffalo offense is in good hands with him under center. The junior quarterback from Lampasas, Texas, connected on 27-of-42 passes for a on a career-high 379 yards and six touchdowns on Saturday afternoon as the No. 16 West Texas A&M football team recovered from a slow start that was blemished by a rash of penalties to earn a 63-20 victory over Adams State at Rex Field in Alamosa, Colo. ...Brandon Swain was a big part of the West Texas A&M defensive effort that guided the Buffs to victory over Adams State on Saturday afternoon. The junior defensive end contributed six tackles (including 1.5 for losses), his team-leading second sack of the season, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery...The Buffs improved to 2-0 on the season after dominating Adams State during their road opener in Alamosa, Colo., 63-20 ... WTAMU piled up 646 yards of total offense, a figure that included 414 yards through the air and 232 on the ground ... On the receiving end, redshirt freshman A.J. Ruffins enjoyed a breakout performance by hauling in six passes for 110 yards and a pair of touchdowns, while junior Charly Martin also topped the century mark in receiving yards, with six catches for 107 yards and two touchdowns ... The Buffalo defense was solid on the afternoon, allowing only 206 yards of total offense to the Grizzlies, a figure that including only 29 rushing yards against, and forced three Adams State turnovers ... WTAMU, unfortunately, was flagged 21 times during the contest, amassing 210 yards of penalties ... The Buffs improved to 12-1 on the road in three seasons under head coach Don Carthel and Saturday's game also marks the sixth time that WTAMU has put up at least 50 points during Carthel's tenure.
