

Dear Students and Parents:

In Deer Park ISD, all STAAR EOC testing of out-of-district (OOD) and out-of-school (OOS) examinees will occur at Deer Park High School - Wolters Campus located at 204 Ivy Ave. Deer Park, TX 77536.

Out-of-district (OOD) and out-of-school (OOS) examinees may now register to take assessments for the April 2019 State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR[®]) end-of-course (EOC) (English 1 and English 2) and for the May 2019 (Algebra, Biology, and US History) administrations at any participating Texas campus. Refer to the *April and May 2019 End-of-Course Out-of-District and Out-of-School Test Site Directory*, available at https://texasassessment.com/uploads/2019_staar_eoc_april_may_test_site_directory_master_tagged.pdf, for a list of participating campuses.

Examinees must register online at <https://texastests.com/forms/student-reg-eoc/> for the April and May 2019 STAAR administrations.

The April 2019 STAAR EOC OOD and OOS registration for English 1 and 2 window closes **February 1, 2019**.

The May 2019 STAAR EOC OOD and OOS registration for Algebra, Biology, and US History window closes **March 1, 2019**.

Deer Park ISD will administer the assessments as follows, testing will start at 8:45 AM each morning:

- English I – April 9
- English II – April 11
- Algebra I – May 7
- Biology – May 6
- U.S. History – May 8

Because the TAKS tests are no longer being administered, former TAKS examinees (including former TAAS and TEAMS examinees) will take the STAAR Algebra EOC, STAAR English 2 EOC, STAAR Biology EOC, and STAAR US History EOC test(s). STAAR scores will be matched to the appropriate TAKS passing standard.

On the day(s) of testing, examinees should arrive at the test site 30 minutes before the designated testing time. EOC examinees must present picture identification to test. EOC examinees will not be able to take the assessment(s) without a picture ID, such as a driver's license, DPS ID, military ID, school ID, or resident alien card to test.
