

Dear Students and Parents:

In Deer Park ISD, all STAAR EOC testing of out-of-district (OOD) and out-of-school (OOS) examinees will occur at Deer Park High School - Wolters Campus located at 204 Ivy Ave. Deer Park, TX 77536.

Out-of-district (OOD) and out-of-school (OOS) examinees may now register to take assessments for the March and May 2017 State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR[®]) end-of-course (EOC) administrations at any participating Texas campus. Refer to the *March and May 2017 STAAR EOC OOD and OOS Test Site Directory*, available at <https://www.TexasAssessment.com>, for a list of participating campuses.

Examinees must register online at <https://forms.texasassessment.com/out-of-district-form/> for the March and May 2017 STAAR EOC administrations.

The March 2017 STAAR EOC OOD and OOS registration window closes **February 3, 2017**.

The May 2017 STAAR EOC OOD and OOS registration window closes **March 3, 2017**.

The assessments will be administered as follows, testing will start at 8:45 AM each morning:

- English I – March 28
- English II – March 30
- Algebra I – May 2
- Biology – May 1
- U.S. History – May 3

Districts testing registered OOD and OOS examinees will receive precoded materials for these testers. Examinees who are not registered online by the deadline may still participate at a selected campus on the day of testing, if the campus can accommodate them, and must be registered by campus personnel on the day of testing.

On the day(s) of testing, examinees should arrive at the test site 30 minutes before the designated testing time. Examinees must present picture identification to test. Examinees will not be able to take the assessment(s) without a picture ID.
